The message below was taken from an email sent to all of the medical staff of the Tennessee Valley Veterans Administration on Wednesday 12/30/2020 after the VA started giving the Moderna Vaccine to all employees that wanted it. This email was sent out in attempt to alleviate some of the doubt and questions other employees may have about taking the vaccine:

Hello Fellow Co-Workers

I wanted to encourage you all to consider getting the vaccine ASAP. I realize there is some apprehension but it really is a great vaccine. It sounded rushed but they rushed the parts that didn't involve the outcome studies. (making millions of doses before they knew if it was effective) They did the usual large participant studies as usual.

Some are concerned about this being a mRNA vaccine. "What if it changes my DNA?" If you recall RNA is transcribed from the DNA and does not go the other way around. The vaccine is safe. You wouldn't see smart guys like Dr. Hulgan (infectious disease MD and Christman-Chief of Medicaine) running to it. With that, it's not just for smart guys. I raced here on my day off when I heard I could get it.

It doesn't hurt (I swear, I actually didn't feel it at all but I'm tougher than your average psychiatrist) You can do this! You can do this for you, your pts, your families, and your community.
